### Produce

#### In 2013, we delivered:



84,862 bunches of local, organic greens (lettuce, kale, collards, dandelions, etc.)




47,724 pounds of local, organic apples  
That's like delivering 120 full-grown gorillas.



100% of the produce we delivered was certified organic and free of GMOs.



 By delivering our produce in reusable green bins, we saved enough cardboard boxes to build 62 Empire State Buildings!

### Environment



We made 3,412 deliveries by cargo bike.



We composted 33,450 lbs of produce.

We also recycled enough cardboard to save 624 adult trees.

In 2013, we proudly became a certified B Corporation.
